

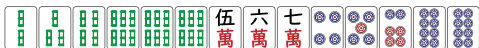
1-HAN HANDS

🌀 **Riichi** 立直 *Riichi* | Closed waiting hand declared with 1,000 of the caller's points put on the table.

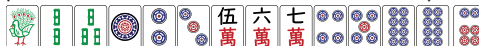
🌀 **Fully Concealed Hand** 門前清自摸 *Menzen tsumo* | Winning with a self-drawn tile on a fully concealed hand.

🌀 **Unbroken** 一発 *Ippatsu* | Win on the turn after declaring riichi. There must be no interruption from any call (except another riichi declaration).

All Inside 断么九 *Tan'yao* | No terminal or honour tiles.



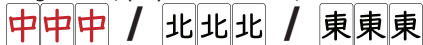
🌀 **Pinfu** 平和 *Pinfu* | Four sequences and a valueless pair. Must win with a two-sided wait on a sequence.



🌀 **Twin Sequences** 一盃口 *Ipeikō* | Two identical sequences in the same suit.



Value Honour 役牌 *Yakuhai* | Triplet (or quad) of dragon tiles, player's seat wind, or the round wind.

2-HAN HANDS

🌀 **Double Riichi** ダブル立直 *Daburu Riichi* | Win with a riichi declared on your first discard.

🌀 **Seven Pairs** 七対子 *Chiitoitsu* | Seven different pairs.



🌀 **Full Straight** 一气通貫 *Ikkitsūkan/Ittsū* | Three sequences of the same suit forming 1-2-3, 4-5-6, and 7-8-9.



🌀 **Mixed Sequences** 三色同順 *Sanshoku dōjun* | Same numerical sequence in each suit.



🌀 **Common Ends** 全帯ヤオ *Chanta* | All groups and the pair containing at least one terminal or honour tile. Contains at least one sequence.



Mixed Triplets 三色同刻 *Sanshoku dōkō* | Three triplets (or quads) of the same number in each suit.



Three Concealed Triplets 三暗刻 *San'ankō* | Three entirely concealed triplets (or quads) of any tile. May not ron on triplets. Rest of the hand may be called.



Three Quads 三槓子 *Sankantsu* | Three quads.



All Triplets 对々和 *Toitoi* | Four triplets (or quads) and a pair.



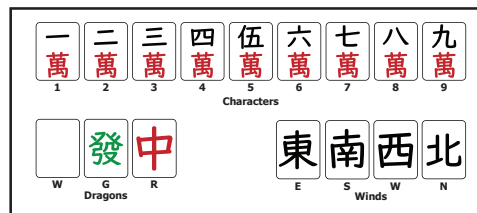
Common Terminals 混老頭 *Honrōtō* | Only terminal and honour tiles.



Little Dragons 小三元 *Shōsangen* | Two dragon triplets (or quads) and a pair of dragon tiles.

3-HAN HANDS

🌀 **Double Twin Sequences** 二盃口 *Ryanpeikō* | Two Twin Sequences. Does not stack with Twin Sequences.



🌀 **Common Flush** 混一色 *Hon'itsu* | Groups and the pair containing only tiles from one suit and honour tiles.



🌀 **Perfect Ends** 純全帯 *Junchan* | At least one terminal tile in each group.



6-HAN HANDS

🌀 **Perfect Flush** 清一色 *Chin'itsu* | Only number tiles from one suit.



YAKUMAN

🌀 **Thirteen Orphans** 国士無双 *Kokushi musō* | One tile of each type of terminal and honour and one additional terminal or honour tile.



🌀 **Nine Gates** 九蓮宝燈 *Chūren pōtō* | 1112345678999 in the same suit, plus one additional tile of that suit.



🌀 **Four Concealed Triplets** 四暗刻 *Sūankō* | Four triplets (or quads) without calling.



Four Quads 四槓子 *Sūkantsu* | Four quads.



All Green 緑一色 *Ryūūisō* | Only green tiles. (Bamboo 2, 3, 4, 6, 8 & green dragon tiles.)

🌀 **Perfect Terminals** 清老頭 *Chinrōtō* | Four triplets (or quads) and a pair with only terminal tiles.



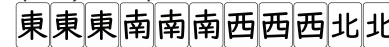
All Honours 字一色 *Tsūisō* | Only honour tiles.



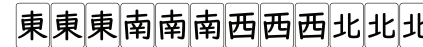
Big Dragons 大三元 *Daisangen* | Three triplets (or quads) of dragon tiles.



Little Winds 小四喜 *Shōsūshii* | Three triplets (or quads) and a pair of wind tiles.



Big Winds 大四喜 *Daisūshii* | Four triplets (or quads) of wind tiles.
